## **Stewardship: Time and Talent Descriptions**

### **Church Ministry**

Eucharistic Minister: Distribute Holy Communion at Mass (must be Confirmed).

Homebound Minister: Go to those unable to come to church to bring the Eucharist.

Eucharistic Adoration: Spend quiet time praying, reading and Adoring the Blessed Sacrament (one hour a month).

Sacristan: Prepare the Credence, side and gift tables prior to Mass. May assist the Eucharistic Ministers during Mass.

Assist the priest before and after Mass.

Gift Bearer: Two persons (or family) take the bread, wine and water to the altar during the offertory.

Lector: Participate in Mass by reading the scriptures, prayers of the faithful, announcements, responses, etc.

Greeter: Greet and welcome people as they arrive at Mass.

Usher: Assist with seating people before Mass, collect the offertory envelopes, and help carry the gifts if needed.

Prayer Line: Serve on a phone tree and pray for those in need, along with notifying the next person on the phone tree or list.

Religious Ed Teacher/Helper: Help to form our children in our Faith (must be Confirmed).

Vacation Bible School/Totus Tuus: Assist with a week long program held in the summer.

Hospitality Weekend: Refreshments and snacks after Mass.

Lead Rosary: Weekends or weekday Masses

Lock St. Mary's Church: In the evenings at 7 or 8 pm.

Children's Liturgy of the Word: At the St. Mary's 10 am Mass on Sundays

Money Counters: Counts weekend Contributions on Mondays once a month

### **Music Ministry**

Choir: Practice as needed. Sing and /or play an instruments at the scheduled weekend Mass.

### **Committees & Misc.**

Building/Grounds Maintenance: Assist with the maintenance of the church building and property as needed.

Cemetery Upkeep: Helps mow lawn and general maintenance.

Social Justice: Work to share time and charitable giving to those in need. Ie: food shelves, help for the elderly and the sick with manual tasks.

Seasonal Decorating: Help decorate and take down decorations ( Christmas and Easter etc).

Special Events/Fundraising: Plan and help at special events and fundraising functions in your parish.
