

Communion Line for receiving on the tongue

In light of the Covid restrictions being removed, Bishop Kettler encourages that there remains a separate line for those choosing to receive communion on the tongue instead of in the hand. As you know, with the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965), permission was granted to receive Jesus in the hand. Pope Paul VI (1963-1978): "This method [on the tongue] must be retained." Fr David/presiding priest will be the designated line for communion on the tongue the next few months. If you have any health concerns regarding the virus, simply receive Jesus in the hand from the Eucharistic Minister.

NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

Every time we gather for the Eucharist, we offer simple gifts of bread and wine that become Christ's Body and Blood for all to share. These basic food and drink that we bring to the table become the flesh and blood of Our Savior. His Body and Blood nourishes us as we carry out His mission. Most of us realize now how much we miss receiving the Eucharist for an extended period of time due to the pandemic. Therefore, let us approach the table of the Lord in joy and gratitude for God's abiding presence in this sacred meal. How can we as parishes become more the "Eucharistic People" we are called to become?

Thanks to the American Legion, High School Marching Band, etc. who helped bring about this glorious day in Upsala! It was so great how so many people came out for this day. This was my first experience and it was most touching simply hearing all the names of those gone before us marked in the sign of faith. What a beautiful Veteran's Memorial Park you have in our community. I could not help but think it would be nice to have an Outdoor Sunday Mass there in July or August. This would be a small way to bring attention to all those names listed in this memorial.

As Covid restrictions for the most part have been lifted, I greatly appreciate your sensitivity to those who still somewhat reticent. Perhaps you or your loved ones still feel greatly compromised and want to do what you can to protect yourselves. Please reach out to me if you have suggestions as to how better we can keep our guard up against this virus. I hope that you can find a place to worship with us while creating some social distance for yourselves. I plan to wear face covering the next few months while distributing Holy Communion to remain in solidarity with you. Remember during the sign of peace, some people may feel uncomfortable shaking hands. Both Communion lines will come forth side-by-side as we did prior to the pandemic. Communion will be brought to those who are physically unable to come forward.

I will be gone to a Priest's Retreat held in Steubenville, OH: June 14-18. Please remember to keep me in your prayers. This is a great time to gather with priests, deacons and seminarians throughout the country. We will listen to dynamic speakers, praise God with some awesome worship music, profound times of Eucharistic Adoration, Sacrament of Reconciliation along with some rest and relaxation. Myself and another priest will be flying out to Pittsburgh, PA (take a shuttle to the Franciscan University in Steubenville, OH) Monday morning and returning late Friday evening. Church law states that every priest must make a retreat. Due to the COVID-19, our diocesan retreat scheduled for January 2021 in Buffalo, MN was cancelled. We are blessed to have retired priest Fr Virgil Helmin (320.293.6220) take the weekday Masses for me. He will also be available in case of emergency.
