

NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

This weekend, we heard Jesus tell His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, where He will suffer and be killed and that – guess what? – whoever comes after Him must take up his cross and follow Him. It must have been quite a shock! This is the first time Jesus told them this. We know what happened nearly two thousand years ago, but the challenge is new for each generation of disciples. Are we willing to take up our crosses? Will we follow? Let our sharing in the Eucharist strengthen us as we take up the cross and follow Jesus.

You continually amaze me how so many people came forward for our Parish Raffle/Outdoor Mass held at St Francis. It truly touched my heart seeing parishioners from all three of our parishes. No doubt you are becoming more "our parishes" rather than "my parishes". We didn't sell all 4,000 tickets, however about 3,300 were sold. Thanks to the people of St Francis for being innovative in deciding to have this raffle. Our parishes need to come up with new ways to help ensure that financially we will remain viable.

Especially in light of the Bishop's Directives to implement Area Catholic Communities (ACC). As we begin working more closely with the Holdingford area parishes, in time we will also see this new configuration as "our parishes" and not "my three parishes". Words from Bishop Kettler in his August 25th letter: "We may not be able to do ministry the way we always have, but we shouldn't be doing less. The work of DREs, catechists and youth ministers are crucial right now. We need to be innovative, creative and adaptable. Pastors and parish staff must support one another. Within your ACCs and regions, please work together, collaborate and share resources whenever possible. Brainstorm new and effective ways to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with your parishioners."
