Why is November called the Month of Remembrance?

The month of November is traditionally a time in which the Catholic community remembers those who have died. It is related to the fact that the end of November is the end of the Liturgical Year with a new year starting the First Sunday of Advent – the four-week period of preparation before Christmas. The Church then uses this end of the year period as a time to think of the end of life and the end of all things and the great hope that our earthly end is transition into a new life in God's heavenly reality. All Souls: Help the Souls in Purgatory!

To gain a Plenary Indulgence for the Souls in Purgatory, the following conditions must be met: Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin; receive the sacrament of confession; receive the Holy Eucharist and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary).

If some of the above conditions are not fulfilled, the indulgence becomes partial.

It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act.

One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence. ~catholicculture.org
