Notes from Father David

This weekend we acknowledge that while leaders of nations in this world come and go, Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is ruler over all people both now and forever. The idea to celebrate this feast was born out of a growing nationalism and secularism one hundred years ago. The world had just lived through the horrors of four years of war unprecedented in its spread over the whole world. This led to Pope Pius XI instituting this feast in 1925. This weekend we recognize Christ's preeminence and pray for the day when peace and goodwill forever overcome war and aggression.

A few years ago, our diocese was in the infancy of stages of forming ACC's (Area Catholic Community in which we are joined with the Holdingford area parishes). Pastoral/Parish Councils were phased out in many parishes including ours. On behalf of the diocese and myself, I apologize for how this was done as we failed to consult with you as parishioners and especially with you who were council members. Recently, the Planning Office of our diocese informed me that it is now recommended that each parish have a Parish Life Committee. I believe that this committee would help restore ownership to you. This is your parish. You know better than anyone that priests come and go. The role of this committee is to assist in making the Parish a center for each person to share their talents in both social and spiritual activities, while keeping God as their focus. Parish Life members are encouraged to use their entertainment planning and creative energies to foster an active parish social life. More info in next week's bulletin. If you are interested in learning more about this and/or even help create a Parish Life Committee in your parish, please contact me.

As we gather with our loved ones for Thanksgiving on Thursday, many of us will carry on the tradition of going around the table and sharing what we are thankful for this past year. Here and now let us think of how we are thankful to God. As we come for Mass, we gather around God's table/altar as we bring to mind specific times when we felt the presence of the God who gifted us with life and love, with mercy and salvation, with goodness beyond our imagination.
