The Precious Blood of Christ

O God, who by the Precious Blood of your only Begotten son have redeemed the whole world, preserve in us the work of your mercy, so that, ever honoring the mystery of our salvation, we may merit to obtain its fruits. Through our lord Jesus Christ, your son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the holy spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Admitted to your sacred table, O Lord, we have with joy drawn water from the fountains of the Savior: O may his blood, we beseech thee, become within us a fountain of water springing up to eternal life. ~Aleteia

With these thoughts, perhaps we can let the words of Jesus from today's Gospel enter deeply into our minds and hearts: "Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." May Jesus Himself be the treasure that we seek, and that we will receive him when we open our hearts to his presence and his love.
