Put very simply--Jesus commands us to fast and pray. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Food will be blessed Holy Saturday or Easter morning for your Easter meal, when fasting is ended and the Church is filled with joy. You are encouraged to bring various foods items and place them before the altar of our three churches Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday.
