



#### **Season of Lent: Centered on the Eucharist**

Serving others is not as easy as we think since we are living in a culture that emphasizes self-promotion and self -glorification. Service at its best is Eucharistic Service. In this we exercise our Christian identity. Christianity is not a self-oriented religion but an other oriented religion. Jesus' serving went to the extent of breaking and sharing his body. The Eucharist, the climax of Jesus' self-giving service, not only serves as a constant inspiration to give of ourselves, but also nourishes us on our spiritual journey. It is the food that strengthens us to reach out to others even to the point of sacrificing our life.

Jesus also wanted this spiritual food made available in the church until the end of time; therefore He instituted the Priesthood by authorizing his apostles to continue to do it in His memory (Luke 22:19). Christian service is not possible without the Eucharist. The Eucharist will not be made available without priests. So, we need to pray for our young people to listen to the Lord when they take life's decisions.

During the Last Supper, Jesus offers himself as the Passover sacrifice, the sacrificial lamb, and teaches that every ordained priest is to follow the same sacrifice in the exact same way. Around the world, Bishops and priests come together at their local Cathedrals on Holy Thursday or the Thursday before Holy Thursday evening to celebrate the institution of the priesthood. This is called the Chrism Mass. During the Mass, the bishop blesses the Oils that will be used for Baptism, Confirmation, and Anointing of the sick. Our Chrism Mass will be on Thursday, March 21, 2024, at St. Mary's Cathedral, St. Cloud at 7 pm.

God hears our prayers for the renewal of our Church. He will answer them through a life-changing transformation of our own hearts. The National Eucharistic Revival is an invitation to experience profound personal revival so we can be sent out to share Christ's love with a world that so desperately needs it.
