

In our special readings for the 'Opening of the Synod' this weekend, we are blessed to join all parishes throughout the world for the celebration. In our first reading, we heard "And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit". God so wants us to be filled, but it is dependent upon our receiving. Are you and I truly filled with the Holy Spirit? Too oftentimes, the Holy Spirit can be the forgotten person in the Blessed Trinity. Pope Francis invites the entire Church to reflect on a theme that is decisive for its life and mission: It is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the church of the third millennium.

No doubt you have been as busy as the next person, but if you have a moment, please check out the Caring Bridge website to get up to date on Brayden Harren's journey. His mom Brittany has some very thorough entries spelling out his many challenges. Our little brother has been going through a lot with his leg wraps, sores in his mouth, infections, etc. His family: "The last month or two have been very hard. With COVID-19 and everything, thankfully Brayden has pulled through. He starts treatment once again Oct 27-30 which will be the last of the hard doses (his 5th chemo cycle). The hardest for Brayden is being away from his Daddy, Emmalyn and Carter. One day at a time. How grateful we are for the army of support of prayers and people. It still amazes us every day. We'll get through this one day at a time. We'll lean on each other ... we all have our crosses. For the most part, we are doing good. Brayden is happy and all is well. As Brittany has said, 'we have two choices: stay strong, accept it and go through it or to feel sorry". Let's pray that each one of us will do your part with Brayden's Benefit October 31 fast approaching. It looks like Brittany and Brayden will not be able to join us for the benefit. Please feel free to leave a check in a marked envelope at our weekend Masses if unable to attend.
