NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

In this weekend's Gospel, we hear Jesus calm the raging sea as His disciples' cling to the storm-tossed boat. The disciples were terrified that they would die, but Jesus suggests that their faith should have reassured them. Many of us can probably recall a time when our father came to our rescue, protecting or supporting us, making everything all right. This weekend, we honor our dads, our grandfathers, godfathers, uncles, and all who have acted as fathers in our lives. May their protection and constancy be a model of God's care for us.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation in the Diocese of St. Cloud and all MN dioceses will be reinstated on the weekend of July 3-4. May our parishes be most welcoming these summer months especially to all who have been away from Church for some time. Let's also keep in prayer all those who are still unable to join us. Although the general dispensation will no longer be available, persons in certain circumstances will be excused from observing the obligation:

- 1) Those who have reason to believe their health would be significantly compromised if they were to contract a communicable illness (i.e., they have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category);
- 2) Those who exhibit flu-like symptoms.
- 3) Those who have good reason to think they might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., they were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza).
- 4) Those who care for the sick, homebound or infirmed.
- 5) Those who are pregnant or are 65 years of age or older (per the Centers for Disease Control's recommendation for high-risk individuals)
- 6) Those who cannot attend Mass through no fault of their own (e.g., no Mass is offered; they are infirm; or, while wanting to go, they are prevented for some reason they cannot control, such as their ride did not show up).
- 7) Those who have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by being at Mass.

Allow me to share with you a Holy Spirit moment. Two weeks ago, following the Corpus Christi Procession after the 10am Mass in St Francis, the Lord placed on my heart to consider making a pilgrimage. You may recall how I spoke of Fr Peter of Prague's pilgrimage and the Eucharistic miracle which helped to bring about the first Corpus Christi celebration. Well, it was that very Sunday morning, I received an email that has a pilgrimage to Mexico City December 2-7, 2021. As you know, Our Lady of Guadalupe has appeared there in 1531. What do you think? Are you interested in a pilgrimage?

Next weekend will be the last weekend before our Mass times change. No doubt this change will not be well received by a good number of people, yet I pray that somehow together we can make this work. I greatly appreciate hearing support and encouragement from many people. With no ordinations to the priesthood in the next three years, there is no doubt that changes will be coming. Have you heard that the Catholic School in Marty/Pearl Lake has recently closed?
