Pope Francis in his letter to the married couples said, "Dear spouses, know that your children – especially the younger ones – watch you attentively; in you they seek the signs of a strong and reliable love. How important it is for young people to see with their own eyes the love of Christ alive and present in the love of spouses, who testify by the reality of their lives that love for ever is possible! Children are always a gift; they change the history of every family. They are thirsty for love, gratitude, esteem and trust.
