

there is a chance for mercy. Believe it firmly, do not doubt, do not hesitate, never despair of the mercy of God." ~St. Isidore of Seville

#### How to make a good Confession

It is important to sincerely evaluate our lives before every confession, whether it has been a while before the last confession or if you attend the sacrament regularly.

Has God been number one in your life?

You need to evaluate if God is your priority. If He's not, that's the first thing you need to admit.

Acknowledge your sin.

Sin is not a mistake or an accident; it is knowing what God wants for you but freely deciding to do something else. Ask yourself: when and how have I rejected God's plan for me?

Examination of conscience.

Make an examination according to your age and vocation. It is also useful to follow these steps for a deeper evaluation:

1.Pray the litany of humility. It is a great prayer to understand your wounds and an opportunity to acknowledge that only God can fulfill your life.

3. Examine yourself. St. Ignatius of Loyola came up with a series of steps for a daily examination. This will help you re-evaluate your intentions and to acknowledge the times when you turned away from God's way. <u>Steps for</u> <u>the Daily Examen</u>: Recalling God's presence, expressing thankfulness, looking back on your day, asking for forgiveness & resolving to grow.
