



Pope Francis has declared the new Jubilee Year as the Year of Pilgrims of Hope. This Jubilee Year will officially open at the diocesan level on Sunday, December 29, 2024, the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, with a solemn Mass for Opening the Jubilee Year at the Cathedral of St. Mary in St. Cloud at 6:00 p.m., beginning in the lower level. After gathering, a candlelight pilgrimage procession will proceed from the lower level to the front doors of the cathedral and veneration of the diocesan Jubilee Cross.

# The Octave of Christmas

The octave of Christmas is celebrated as an eight-day feast which begins on the Nativity, December 25th, and continues to January 1st, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God.

Since at least the fourth century, Christians have celebrated the most important liturgical feasts with "octaves" eight days of celebration. Christmas has been celebrated as an octave since at least the seventh century.

During the Christmas octave, the "Gloria" is sung each day during Mass, and each day is generally regarded as a day of great feasting. We also have the liturgical season of Christmas, which ends on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, celebrated in 2025 on January 12th.

Judy Theisen 573-2933 & Joyce Koopmeiners 573-2728(SF) After the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, "ordinary time" begins on the liturgical calendar. There are a lot of Christian cultures which continue to celebrate Christmas until Candlemas which takes place on February 2nd the feast commemorating the presentation of the Lord in the Temple.

The Presentation Feast is called "Candlemas" because it is the day on which the Church has traditionally blessed candles for liturgical use. Why? Because when the infant Jesus was presented in the Temple, St. Simeon called him a "light to the Gentiles" — and the light of Christ has been central to celebrating the presentation ever since. https://www.pillarcatholic.com/.
