

LENT AND 40 DAYS FOR LIFE

40 Days for Life, beginning on Ash Wednesday (February 14), is a focused pro-life campaign with a vision to access God's power through prayer, fasting and peaceful vigil to end abortion. The campaign mission is to bring together the body of Christ in a spirit of unity during a focused 40 days of peaceful activism with the purpose of repentance, to seek God's favor to turn hearts and minds from a culture of death to a culture of life.

Our Catholic faith tradition encompasses seven basic themes for the 40 Days for Life. They help us to prioritize and evaluate our choices.

- **Dignity of the Human Person** All people are sacred, made in the image of God.
- Family & Community Participation The human person is both Sacred & Social. When one suffers, we all suffer.
- Rights & Responsibilities People have a fundamental right to life, food, shelter, health care, education and employment
- Option for the Poor The moral test of society is how it treats its most vulnerable.
- **Dignity of Work** The economy exists to serve people, not people to serve the economy.
- Solidarity We are called to work globally for justice and peace.
- Care for God's Creation We show our respect for the Creator by our protection of the planet and all beings.

Lent is an observance lasting 40 days starting on Ash Wednesday and ending just before Easter Sunday. The purpose of Lent is to focus on Jesus' sacrifice on the cross and the miracle of His Resurrection. The celebration of Lent is not a commandment but an opportunity to renew our faith and live peacefully.

This year, the season of Lent invites us to do our best to live our Vocations. Regardless of where we work and what we do, make sure that our ethics, our morals and our values shine bright and be witnesses to all around us. What Jesus did for the Apostles, he wishes to do for all of us: The Lord wants us to follow Him more closely and more dearly. This Lent, the Lord wants to offer us more grace.
