NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

On this Labor Day weekend, let us take a welcome rest from our labors – be they in a factory or field, store or office, school or home -- and appreciate the time we take with the One who promised that His yoke was easy and His burden was light. This weekend let us pray especially for those whose own burden is difficult: those who need to work more than one joy to support their families, those who do not receive the gratitude and compensation they deserve for their work, and those who are unemployed or underemployed.

People from around the diocese who have lost family members or friends to the coronavirus gathered at St. Francis Xavier in Sartell Aug. 25 for a Mass of Remembrance with Bishop Donald Kettler. "The greatest commandment is to love God with all that we are and to love our neighbor as ourselves," Bishop Kettler said during his homily. "Keeping this great commandment has challenged us and aided us as we lived with the coronavirus, and it calls us tonight to pray for all those we remember and pray for here tonight." As of August 27, 644,190 COVID-19 cases had been reported in Minnesota, according to the Minnesota Department of Health.

No doubt you have seen the horrific aftermath in Haiti. Catholic Charities, Catholic Relief Services among numerous other groups are on the ground in the aftermath of a devastating 7.2 magnitude earthquake in Haiti, where children were already suffering amidst surging COVID-19 cases, severe acute malnutrition and gang violence. The death toll is expected to continue to rise. There are emergency response teams on the ground, assessing survivors' needs, delivering antibiotics and activating local Haitian medical teams to help overwhelmed hospitals. The proceeds of this collection next weekend (all loose collection) will be sent immediately to the Chancery which will then be sent to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Our parish office continues to be a work in progress. This past week, Laura stated that she will be unable to help out in the office as she had planned. Thankfully Jessie Johnson who is from the parish of St Anna has expressed her willingness to help out. She had been the Secretary in the Holdingford area parishes, thus there will be some familiarity with what needs to be done. Thank you for your prayers that the right person will come forth as Secretary/Bookkeeper or as Office Manager.
