The Commemoration of All Saints and All Souls

November 1 is the Solemnity of All Saints, not a holy day of obligation this year, it is a celebration of all those who enjoy the gift of eternal life in the presence of God, the completion of the pilgrimage of faith. These holy women and men from every age pray for us, and inspire us to follow in the footsteps of Christ to know the same joy that is theirs without end.

All Souls, November 2, falls on Sunday this year and it is a fitting opportunity to remember all those who have died. Some of the most important questions in life are: "Will I grow in holiness, go to heaven, and see Jesus face to face?" "Will I be at the everlasting family reunion in heaven?" The Church teaches clearly that there are three possible ends for every soul: hell, purgatory, and heaven.

St. Augustine once wrote, 'God who created you without you, will not save you without you.' In other words, salvation is a gift, but it requires our cooperation. Pope St. John Paul II said: "In a word, we can say that the cultural change which we are calling for demands from everyone the courage to adopt a new lifestyle, consisting in making practical choices - at the personal and social level."

There is both a quantity and quality of fruit that God expects us to produce in our earthly life (Lk 13:6-9), our fruit of personal holiness and 'good works' (Rev 14:13). God is much more than 'the Man upstairs.' He is our Savior, Friend and also our Judge, Who "will test the quality of each one's" good works and holiness (1 Cor 3:13). Some of the dead who die in the Lord will not have lived a life as fruitful as God expected. God in His mercy will still grant them eternal life. Thus, these deceased folks 'will suffer loss,' yet "will be saved, but only as one fleeing through fire" (1 Cor 3:15).

Jesus has gone to "prepare a place" for us (Jn 14:2). If we have died in Christ, but aren't yet prepared for His place, then Jesus has to finish the job before He can take us into the heavenly feast. The Catholic Church, guided by the Holy Spirit, has taught that these promises and other truths indicate the existence of a 'place' of purification (Mal 3:2-3) we call it **purgatory**. In purgatory, the souls of those who have not prepared themselves sufficiently in their time on earth are purified for the awesome privilege of seeing God face to face. Since they are fellow members of the body of Christ (Lk 20:38), we need them, and they need us (1 Cor 12:21). Let us help them with our prayers.

We will remember our deceased, from the past year, the weekend of November 1-2, next Saturday and Sunday. Their names are listed inside of the bulletin.

Help the Souls in Purgatory!

To gain a Plenary Indulgence for the Souls in Purgatory, the following conditions must be met: Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin; receive the sacrament of confession; receive the Holy Eucharist and recite prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary).

If some of the above conditions are not fulfilled, the indulgence becomes partial.

It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act.

One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence. ~catholicculture.org
