Notes from Fr David

This weekend on our journey through this penitential season, we are reminded of the promise the Lord makes to us. God asked Abraham to look up to the heavens and witness the uncountable stars in the sky. Peter, John, and James looked up to the heavens and saw Jesus transfigured to shine like the sun. As we fast, pray, and give alms this Lent, let us pause to look up to the heavens and consider the incredible vastness of the transformation of us and world that God set in motion.

How is your Lenten season starting out? There are many ways to grow in your faith. I recommend three: a weekday Mass, Stations of the Cross and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Personally, these have brought enormous graces into my life. I know two priests who have since gone Home to Jesus (+ Fr Art Hoppe and + Fr Sylvester Kleinschmidt) from our diocese who prayed the Stations daily! They were very holy priests. They spoke of the graces for the both the living and deceased. When we unite with Jesus in His passion, we become deserving of the forgiveness of our sins, the increase of grace, and the reward of everlasting life.

Lastly, I know a good number of you have stayed away from Jesus in Confession. Please consider coming back Home to Him this Lent, no matter how long it has been since your last confession. God the Father is constantly calling us to repentance. I have no idea the reasons why you have chosen not to come to Jesus in this sacrament. We have had many people die from our parishes this past year. I will bet my life that when we die and stand before Jesus, we will be sad and regret not being more faithful to Him. Did you know that the very first thing Jesus did when He appeared to the disciples after His resurrection was give His Apostles this sacrament?
