Hope: The Architecture of Peace Presentation: Sept. 23

National Relic Tour of Eucharistic Saints: Sept. 30 & Oct. 5 Relics of St. Manuel Gonzalez Garcia and Blessed Carlo Acutis will be available for veneration in parishes around the Diocese of St. Cloud between Sept. 30 and Oct. 5. The relics are on tour as part of the National Eucharistic Revival, three-year focus on the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. St. Mary Parish in Alexandria will be the first stop the diocesan tour with a youth event Friday, Sept. 30, titled "Evening with the Saints" at 6:00 p.m.; veneration on Saturday, Oct. 1, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., followed by 5 p.m. Mass, and resuming veneration until 6:30 p.m.

A Note from Father

Two teachings of Jesus mark the center of today's Gospel. He states, "No servant can serve two masters." And then he affirms, "You cannot serve both God and mammon."
