Notes from Fr David

We draw close to the end of this season of expectation, this season of preparation, this season of waiting. For three weeks we have been anticipating that glorious day that is now just over the horizon. Let us break from all the hustle and bustle that threaten to overwhelm the true meaning of this holy event and share in the pure joy of Mary and Elizabeth, two mothers expecting their first children, who in our weekend's Gospel exult in each other's blessedness.

I loved the powerful testimonies given at the end of our Sunday 10am Mass last weekend. Emily Blonigen (daughter of Pat and Kris) from St Edward's: "I and so many others kids went on a NCYC trip in Indiana. This was the first time for me. I didn't know what to expect, but I knew that it would be fun. My friends told me about it two years ago and I would regret it if I didn't go. It was eye-opening to see 10,000 people praying and worshipping together in a stadium. Seeing so many people singing together is a moment that I never want to forget. I recommend 100% younger kids to go on the trip next year. It changed the way I see God and Church. I had conversations with my friends about religion that we have never talked about before. Adoration was so different from any time I have gone. It helped me grow closer to God to see things in a different light. I am so grateful that I was able to go on this trip. I appreciate all the people who prayed for us, who chaperoned and all who helped put this trip together."

Katie Jensen (daughter of Eric and Julie) from St Mary's: "This was my second year going on the trip. I was a sophomore back in 2019. I was so excited to go on the trip again, but super nervous that I wasn't going to have the same experience. But this trip was so different from the first one. It was really similar but with not having as many people. Last time there was 22,000 people and this year it was 10,000. It caused a more intimate experience that I never had. Through adoration and confession, I had an amazing 'God-experience'! It was really great! When we went back to our hotel room, I shared it with Gracie, Katelyn and Emily. We talked about two hours about adoration. I never had that with anyone else. I just knew that those are the graces that God brings on trips like these. It was an absolutely amazing experience. I am really grateful for this opportunity."

And so, what can our parishes do to help our young people continue to deepen their relationship with Jesus? With their fire and enthusiasm for their faith, we are compelled to come forth in new and life-giving ways that will help develop their faith which will impact our faith.
