## Memorial of St. Thomas Aquinas, January 28th

We all have doctors to look after our physical health, and the great news for Catholics is that we also have extraordinary physicians to care for our souls! Across history, the church has proclaimed 38 saints as Doctors of the Church, and foremost among them is St. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274), who mingled philosophy with theology as he wrote some of the most important treatises and books we have on doctrine and church teaching, most notably the *Summa Theologica*, or sum of theology.

In a world where everyone seems obsessed with the future, we can marvel over a saint who believed that reverent understanding of the past is far more important, and St. Thomas spent his relatively brief life deeply reading the church fathers and the great writers of antiquity--most notably Aristotle. His life's work was about striving to teach us all how to know and love God, and his defenses of the Incarnation and the Trinity are definitive. He had many friends including St. Albert the Great and St. Bonaventure, and likely one of them read first his most famous quote of all: *To one who has faith, no explanation is necessary. To one without faith, no explanation is possible.* St. Thomas of Aquinas, pray for us! ~Jeff Johnson




### **This Week on FORMED**
