NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

Often we hear what we want to hear, not what we need to hear. It's only human; even St Peter show this tendency. When Jesus told His disciples that He would suffer and be killed, Peter immediately drew Him aside and criticized Him. Not only did Jesus rebuke him, He told the crowd that everyone who follower Him must suffer as well, must willingly take up their cross. Let us pray for the courage to take up our crosses, comforted with the knowledge that God always accompanies us in our struggles.

Pray for the priests of the St Cloud Diocese as we will have our 45th Annual Pastoral Workshop Sunday, October 3 – 6 at the Arrowwood Conference Center in Alexandria. For the last two years due to COVID-19 we were unable to meet. There will be no daily Masses here Tuesday and Wednesday. Bishop Mark Seitz from the Diocese of El Paso, TX will be speaking about how we, priests, can better celebrate the Mass. He will also go into the connection he personally makes between the Mass and care for those at the border. Generally, this provides a wonderful opportunity to reconnect with fellow priests and deacons whom we have not seen for some time. I love talking with your former Pastors about their time in our parishes.

Thank you for your generosity this weekend with our special collection for the people of Haiti. As we along all catholic parishes within country will help make a difference for them. The great many hospitals, schools and homes collapsed, claiming hundreds of lives, and leaving communities in crisis. About 1.2 million people, including 540,000 children, have been affected by the powerful earthquake. Children and their families urgently need health care and clean water.
