

NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

When we come together this weekend, we receive the Lord – the Bread of life – in the Eucharist. He satisfies our hunger, be it material or spiritual. When we receive the Lord, in the Eucharist and into our hearts, He brings fullness, mission, God's grace, and the promise of everlasting life into our poor, imperfect, and needy human lives. He enables us to "put away the old self" and "put on the new self." Joined together with our brothers and sisters in faith, let us celebrate the generosity of our Lord. For three weekends, scripture readings will focus on the Most Holy Eucharist.

"Older people are not 'leftovers' to be discarded; rather, they continue to be precious nourishment for families, young people and communities" Pope Francis said in the homily for the Mass marking the first World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly last Sunday. "Let us ask ourselves, 'Have I visited my grandparents, my elderly relatives, the older people in my neighborhood? Have I listened to them? Have I spent time with them?'" the pope said. "Let us protect them, so that nothing of their lives and dreams may be lost. May we never regret that we were insufficiently attentive to those who loved us and gave us life." The world-wide celebration will be the 4th Sunday of July every year.

Our Diocese has a parish nurse program; I was blessed in my previous assignments to have a Parish Nurse involved in helping reach our shut-ins and elderly. I am trying to reach out and visit them, but there is no doubt that I am falling short in this ministry. This person would reach out to those in our communities in Nursing Homes and other facilities as well as people who still live in their homes. Please join in prayer asking the Holy Spirit to come upon us as our parishes discern God's will in considering Parish Nurse Ministry at this time. Pope Francis said in last Sunday's homily: "Grandparents and the elderly are not leftovers from life, scraps to be discarded...They are a precious source of nourishment."

We have much activity taking place between now and the start of the school year. From my vacation up north August 6-13, Guest Speaker August 7-8, Heritage Days August 14, Helping Hands weekend collection (August 14-15), August 15th Chad Poppenhagen (SM) becoming Catholic and Faith Hartung (SF) getting confirmed and then our Fall Festival in St Francis August 22. Please note that that was not a typo. As "our" churches continue to decline in membership, we need to see our three parishes as "ours" and not "yours" and "mine."
