

Notes from Father David

"The Lord is Risen!" "I am with you always," Jesus assures His disciples even as He ascends to His Father in heaven. Indeed, He is with us here today: in the Word, proclaimed so that we may be enlightened; in the Eucharist, offered for us and received by us; in the priest, who resides over this celebration; and in each other, as we gather in His name. Jesus promised His disciples that He would not leave them orphans. We rely on that promise today and always as we seek to follow Him and carry out our mission.

Congrats to all our High School Graduates. The Christian faith is lived out in community. You'll need to find a good church. Somewhere for you to worship, learn, grow, and serve. Somewhere you can form friendships and where you can be a friend. Assessing situations, weighing alternatives, and thinking critically are like using muscles. Flabbiness comes from disuse; strength comes through practice. We trust that you will make the best decisions you can based on sound judgment, accept the consequences, learn from any missteps, and trust God to shower you with mercy and goodness (Psalm 23:6).

Our parishes are blessed to have three of the five top honor students for Upsala High School: Paige Gerads is honored as "Class of 2023 Salutatorian". She is the daughter of Jamie and Becky Gerads.
