This weekend we are reminded that one day Jesus will return in glory as the world comes to an earth-shattering conclusion. As frightening as the warnings are in our readings, they are accompanied by assurances that God remains with us. Always. Indeed, soon we will be reminded that Emmanuel means "God is with us." Jesus - Emmanuel – will return in glory at the end of time. Let us pray in thanksgiving this weekend for God's abiding presence with us here on earth.

I am so grateful that Word of Life Free Lutheran Church in Upsala is hosting Thanksgiving Day Meal on November 25 serving 11:30am-1:30pm. This meal for anyone. This is especially targeted for those who may not have a place to go. Too oftentimes there are people in our neighborhood or area who may feel isolated or forgotten. You know the people much better than I. Would you be so kind as to either let them know of this meal or let me know as I can invite them.
