## Notes from Fr David

We complete the fifty-day celebration of Easter the feast of Pentecost, we try to imagine the world before the coming of the Holy Spirit. For many centuries, people did not have any sense of the possibility, God was in the Heavens, unreachable and unintelligible. Later, prophets imagined the spirit of the LORD animating our lives and our world. But not until Jesus spoke of the Spirit and promised the Advocate to His disciples did this gift from God seem real. Let us realize how fortunate we are at this stage of history, blessed with God's abiding presence with us in the Holy Spirit.

In the parable of the talents (Mt 25:14-30) goes beyond what earlier texts state. Not only does Christ expect faithfulness in duty and preparedness even through a long delay, but He also expects an improvement upon what He initially bestowed. It will be most interesting to assess your participation in our "Stewardship: Time and Talent Survey". One church I know organizes a ministry fair with lots of engaging information about different programs and someone on hand to talk about each ministry, committee, etc. Thank you for being open. This can be the first step as we ask for outpouring of the Holy Spirit.
