Epiphany!

Catholics celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany January 4th, and at the heart of this story is the idea of *manifestation*, which we have when we bring that Greek word into English. Through the Gospel of Matthew we learn of the wealthy wise men who journey to inhabit the first moment the infant Jesus appears outside the Holy Family as King of the entire Universe.

For us, the lessons of this vital story are clear and urgent. Like the Magi, we are called to journey, to look up, and also fulfill the prophecy of Isaiah: *Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come*" (Is. 60:1ff). At the same time, we must be aware that the spirt of hateful, murderous Herod is the spirit of the world that endlessly wants to stop our sacred impulse to pursue the light of Christ. With complete faith and hope in the Divine Will of God, symbolized by all our Christmas candles, we "return home by another way," saying no to sin, and yes to the promises of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, and the silence of the manger. Across this new year, look for the quiet, small ways Jesus manifests in our lives in the forms of grace, and blessings from God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. ~ Jeff Johnson


