We hope that all will join us Sunday, May 30th for our 10am Outdoor Mass as we mark the end of Easter! In light of the pandemic, we plan to have our 10am Mass outdoors through the month of June. July will mark a new Mass schedule as you will be asked to have the Saturday for the next year. What time would work best for our parishes?

NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus tells His disciples to remain in His love as He remains in His Father's love. Love is a bond between them that lasts forever. For many of us, the first lasting bond we formed was with our mothers. We honor them today, and all who have acted as mothers in our lives, recognizing that they likely taught us what love was. May that bond teach us now how to remain in Christ's love.

Congratulation to our 10 First Communicants, Parents, Teachers, Coordinators and all family members who helped make this day unforgettable! I pray that our children's love for the Eucharist spurs us to deepen our love for Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Our diocese asks that we have a 'Mission Appeal" every three years and they assign a given missionary group. We are blessed to welcome Fr Benedict to our parishes May 15-16: "Our Diocese is in Kenya (East Africa) and it covers an area of 25,000 miles with 44 parishes that are run by diocesan priests and missionary priests. It has 99 diocesan priests, 13 missionary priests, 12 religious congregations, one newly established congregation for women, two diocesan hospitals, one missionary hospital, and 14 dispensaries. It also sponsors several Primary Schools and Secondary Schools, two Schools for the Deaf, three Special Education Schools, all in two big districts." There will be a second collection.

After much prayer, discussions and discernment, I have made the decision that one of our Churches will have a permanent Mass time while two of our parishes will still alternate every year between the Saturday Mass and the 8am Sunday Mass. St Edward's and St Francis will be asked to do the later. St Mary's will have the permanent 10am Mass on Sundays. One could see this as somewhat of a compromise between the schedule our parishes have been doing and what the Planning Office of the Diocese is asking of us. In talking with neighboring pastors in Randall and Royalton, they are doing something similar to what we will implement, that is, one parish is permanent while the other two alternates. No doubt this is not fair. We are all called to sacrifice. I firmly believe that this is the best for our Three Saint Parishes.

When will this begin? The month of July. For the month of June, we will have our 10am Mass outdoors at St Francis. Please remember to bring a lawn chair. I ask for your patience as we move forward. It is great seeing our churches become more filled. Continue to spread the word and keep inviting people to join us for Holy Mass. Let us pray that before long this pandemic will take leave and our lives will return better than ever!

Next on my agenda is to begin scheduling Masses in our cemeteries. I think that it is ever important that we pray and spend time with our deceased loved ones. There are many graces available when we deepen our relationship with them along with all the Poor Souls in Purgatory.
