Notes from Fr David

Thousands of people, many of them sick and all of them hungry, walked for miles from towns throughout Galilee just to see and hear Jesus. How fortunate we are that Jesus is with us here whenever we gather in His name. He nourishes us at the altars of our churches, strengthening our weaknesses and fortifying us for our own journeys. Let us pray that we may all eat and be satisfied at the Eucharist.

Please see the list of all Parishes, Catholic Schools and all Parishes which have closed. Listing these are part of the process the courts are asking of us as we have filed for bankruptcy reorganization. If you were abused or suffered injury by someone working for our Diocese of St Cloud and you contend that our diocese is responsible, please act now to file your claim. The deadline for making claim is October 21, 2020. In the entrance of our churches there is information posted or call (520) 770-8712 or go online: http://stcdio.org/ and click on the link to the bankruptcy forms and instruction. There will be a notice published monthly in our bulletin. Parishes are also asked by Bishop Kettler to read a letter from the pulpit by Bishop Kettler. I will read this letter on the weekends of August 29-30 and October 3-4.

Raffle tickets for our parish of St Francis Church are now available throughout our area. As sister parishes, St Edward's and St Mary's let us show our support for them. Thanks to all those who donated prizes. Donation for each ticket is only \$5. We printed 4,000 tickets as I hope and pray that come August 23 all tickets will be sold! They will be sold in entrances of St Mary's and St Edward's at the weekend Masses August 15/16. Remember that the Slewfoot Family Band will be playing and singing before after the Outdoor Mass at 2pm!

Bishop Kettler: "I support the requirement to wear face coverings because they are an effective means of protecting the health and safety of parishioners and community neighbors as the statewide process of reopening continues and more people return to Mass and parish activities. Along with hand-washing and physical distancing, it is among the simplest ways to limit the spread of the coronavirus, including by those who are asymptomatic or pre-symptomatic." I want to thank you for doing your part in wearing face coverings. Know that young children and people with special medical conditions are exemptions. If you cannot wear please do not feel guilty. You have to know what is best for you. For the rest of us, obedience is not always easy as I encourage you to look to the Cross and remind ourselves of what Jesus did for us.

Thank you for the prayers as First Friday (August 7) is beginning to take shape. To date, I have five people interested in a home visit. I will make available the sacraments of Holy Communion, Anointing and Confession. I am excited to get into their homes and become more acquainted with them.
