Notes from Fr David

"Love one another," Jesus tells His disciples. No, Jesus commands His disciples. This is how everyone will know that they are His disciples. As we gather here this weekend, we ask ourselves if we can be recognized by our love. Do we show the love we have for one another in what we do and say? Do we love one another as much as Jesus loves us? May the God of love bless us in the challenge to love each other.

Christ is risen! And, so I challenge our graduating seniors to step-back for a moment, almost to remove yourselves and observe it as if you were someone looking in from the outside, I challenge you to consider the impact your lives will make, and how much of that will be shaped by what you do in the next months and years.
