Notes from Father David

On this final Sunday of Lent before Palm Sunday, we hear Jesus call Lazarus from the tomb. Jesus calls us forth from our tombs of sin and death, where our harmful habits and attitudes separate us from God, from life. He is the resurrection. He is the life. Jesus' words to Martha then are His words to us now: Do you believe this? Do you believe that God can bring life out of death? Do you believe that God can free us from the burial bands of sin? Let us recover that faith within us and so prepare ourselves to witness the Resurrection.

I hope everyone will be joining us this year for the numerous presentations of "Journey with Jesus to Calvary" held at St Francis. Even if you have seen it in the past, there are more graces to be received. The Holy Spirit profoundly touched my heart last year. It is most powerful to spend time reflecting on the love of Jesus. Each character adds something special and occasionally some light heartedness makes it way into the scenes. I cannot even begin to imagine the number of hours that the various actors are putting into this ministry. How they remember all their lines is beyond me. Please come and show your support.

I pray that your schedule allows time for you to come to Jesus for our Penance Service this Sunday, March 26 from 2-5pm at All Saints-St Mary's in Holdingford. Please note that our parishes have some individual confession times available. If we truly want to resurrect, it is vitally important that we come to this Sacrament of Reconciliation. For myself personally I receive so many graces. I try to receive Jesus in this sacrament every two weeks. I know that St John Paul II received this sacrament daily. I believe when our parishes receive this sacrament on a more regular basis, we will begin to see and receive more graces!

In light of two Holy Thursday Masses this year, there will be no foot washing. Instead, there will be an opportunity for you to bring food items for the local food shelves. We will have adoration taking place after the Masses. Good Friday services will take place earlier in the day which will allow you to attend the Tenebrae Service held Good Friday evening from 8-9pm at St Mary's Cathedral. Our Easter Vigil at St Edward's will include Sally Hansen (fiancé of Ted Lewandowski) receiving her First Holy Communion and Confirmation. It would be awesome to have a baptism!
