
CONFIRMATION CHOIR

LENTEN PENITENTIAL REGULATIONS

The current discipline is as follows:

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. That is, limited to a single, full meal and abstinence from meat.
- The other Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- The law of fasting permits only one full meal a day, but it does allow the taking of some food in the morning and a second light meal at noon, or in the evening, as you prefer Persons from 18 years of age to 59 years are obligated to fast.
- The law of <u>abstinence from meat</u> applies to all persons who have completed their $14^{\rm th}$ year of age. However, it is highly recommended that children from ages 7 to 14 also follow the law of abstinence.
