"The Lord is Risen!" "I will not leave you orphans," Jesus promises His disciples in this weekend's Gospel, emphasizing the importance of the care that a parent gives. the Mayflower Pilgrims? This was dedicated on August 1,1889. It honors their ideals as later generally embraced by the United States. It is thought to be the world's largest solid granite monument. This is located in Plymouth, Massachusetts nearly forgotten as it is a residential area. Notice how "Faith" has her right hand pointing toward Heaven. "He is Risen indeed!"
