Holy Thursday Masses

In Christ's time, washing of feet happened all the time when they came to one another's home. Now when people come to our homes, we offer food and drink. With that in mind along with the COVID virus restrictions, rather than washing of feet, please bring non-perishable food to share with those in need. Palm Sunday/Holy Week

As restrictions continue to lessen, we are grateful that hymnals and missalettes can once again be used. Congregational singing in a limited capacity which will include singing basically all the Mass parts with the exception of the Opening Song, Offertory, Communion and Closing Song. There will be no foot washing for Holy Thursday and the cross is not to be touched during the veneration on Good Friday. Small candles will be allowed for the Easter Vigil.

NOTES FROM FR. DAVID

During Lent, our Lord calls us to make a conversion of the heart. Our parents, teachers, grandparents, neighbors can show us the way, but then it is up to us to commit to Christ's mission. As we approach the days in which we remember Jesus' suffering and death, we ask ourselves if we are willing to resolve to die to sin and live faithfully, selflessly, and courageously in the Lord?

This Sunday, March 21 is a busy day as graces will be flowing. I hope and pray that you will join me at the 'Benefit for Brayden Harren from 12-4pm at Rudolph's Redneck Roost in Holdingford. May more money, kindness and blessings than ever imagine pour forth! From 2-5pm at All Saint's St Mary's in Holdingford will be an opportunity for you to go to confession. Come to Jesus and receive God's healing. Let's trust in Jesus knowing that miracles will happen as everyone comes out of this sacrament feeling better. Why is that? Because Jesus heals, Jesus loves and Jesus forgives no matter what you have done or how long since your last confession.

We will begin the interviewing of those people interested for the Religious Ed Coordinators. I have been leading this discernment as only the Holy Spirit knows what is best for our children, young people and their parents. Our Catechism states, "Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's earliest years. This already happens when family members help one another to grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel.
